Starting pay for this position is between \$15.00 - \$19.68/hour DOE. General Duties: The Detox Associate/Tech works in our medically managed detoxification unit along with a team of experienced RN's, LPN's, Detox Counselors, Recovery Mentors, and Physicians. The Detox Tech position assists the RN/LPN as they collect objective and subjective data from observations, examinations, interviews and written records in an accurate and timely manner. Assist clients as they are being medically detoxified. Documents care provided in the electronic health record. Collaborates with the team to carry out the plan of care. Follows nursing orders and carries out tasks as assigned by RN/LPN. Provides an environment conducive to safety and health. Orientation provided.

Minimum Requirements:

Current CPR certification

For individuals recovering from the disease of alcoholism and/or from other drug addiction, have maintained continuous sobriety for the immediate past two years at the time of hire.

Medical experience is preferred but not required.

Skills required

The ability to communicate well with both patients and other medical staff.

The ability to provide supportive, non judgmental, care to clients recovering from alcohol/substance abuse.

The ability to work as part of a collaborative interdisciplinary team

Duties will include;

1. Taking Vital signs,
2. Keeping detox quiet

3. Answering phones and assist with housekeeping duties,
4. May assist with the intake process,
5. Performing UA's for drug, alcohol and pregnancy testing,
6. Using motivational interviewing and active listening to support clients recovering from drug/alcohol dependence,
7. Checking in visitors and supervise detox clients,
8. Assisting with activities of daily living when indicated,
9. Assuring quality of care by adhering to therapeutic standards; following detox and nursing division's philosophies and standards of care set by the state board of nursing, state nurse practice act, and OAR's for detox programs,
10. Assisting with referrals to outside agencies as indicated,
11. Supervise detox clients
12. Other duties as assigned
