Duties: Work as a member of a treatment team to provide a range of clinically appropriate services to adults, young people, and families. The majority of the clients served are Spanish-speaking. Diagnose and treat mental and emotional disorders related to and caused by substance abuse. Provide clinical services including intake/diagnostic evaluations, case evaluations, and crisis intervention. Provide one-to-one, group and family counseling, case management, home visits, and mental health outreach. Provide mental health screenings, engagement, and counseling for adults, young people, and families at the clinic and local high schools. Develop and maintain strong collaborative relationships with other agencies. Lead psycho-educational, skill

development, process, and family groups. Document clinical activity, present diagnostic and interview findings, clinical evaluations, and recommendations. Maintain clinical records in accordance with regulations and established clinic policies and procedures. Cooperate and work with other agencies and practitioners regarding mutual clientele. Provide on-call services for approximately 8 hours per month for mental health assessments for patients admitted to local emergency room. Work will be performed at BestCare clinics in Madras and Redmond and will require weekly local travel within normal commuting distance. Must work towards gaining Oregon state licensure as a Licensed Professional Counselor

Education: Master's degree in Social Work, Counseling, Psychology, Mental Health Counseling, or closely related field (foreign equivalent accepted).

Experience: Six months' experience as a Substance Use Disorders (SUD) Counselor, Mental Health Clinician with SUD background, Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor (CADC) I or II, Chemical Dependency Counselor, Residential Associate I or similar position.
