Specific Duties:

- Clean offices, hallways, lounges, restrooms, break room, group rooms, stairways, and other work areas so that health standards are met
- Clean building floors by sweeping, mopping, scrubbing, or vacuuming
- Gather and empty trash receptacles and transport trash to disposal areas
- Follow procedures for the use of chemical cleaners and power equipment to prevent damage to floors and fixtures
- Mix water and detergents or acids in containers to prepare cleaning solutions, according to specifications
- Disinfect equipment, counters, chairs, doors, dispensers, and supplies daily
- Dusts items such as blinds, furniture, file cabinets, and windowsills weekly
