Duties:

1. Work closely with other staff as a member of a treatment team.
2. Complete intakes, assessments and treatment plans appropriate for the residential treatment program.
3. Provide one-on-one, group, and family counseling, and case management services, working collaboratively with treatment team members and other agencies, and document those services in the client file.
4. Lead psycho-educational and process groups as assigned.
5. Work with the treatment team to maintain a healthy treatment milieu.
6. Maintain documentation EMR program and client files.
7. Model appropriate counselor behavior to the newer staff and help train and orient new staff to the program.
8. Other duties as assigned by the Program Director.

Qualifications:

1. One year of experience in Behavioral Health, required.
2. Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor or register to obtain certification within 6 months and be certified within 24 months of registration, preferred.
Have knowledge, skills, and abilities demonstrating competence in the following essential job functions:
 - Treatment of substance-related disorders including client evaluation and individual, group, family, and other counseling techniques.
 - Program policies and procedures for client case management and record keeping.
 - Accountability for recording information in the client files assigned to them consistent with those policies and procedures and applicable OAR's.
3. BestCare Treatment Services uses a "Stages of Change/Motivational Interviewing" model of treatment. Counselors are expected to have a strong understanding of these treatment models.
4. Counselors are expected to be proficient with the use of ASAM criteria in determining placement and length of stay for clients.
5. For individuals recovering from the disease of alcoholism and/or from other drug addiction, have maintained continuous sobriety for the immediate past two years at the time of hire.
6. Understanding and competency serving individuals experiencing substance use disorder, including individuals that present with complex substance use, mental health, and/or medical disorders.
7. Possess the ability to meet and network with all community resources to provide the best customer service.
8. Ability to demonstrate good communication, flexibility, and milieu management. Ability to work effectively in a variety of cultural context.

Tools and Equipment Used:

Must have competency using computer for word processing, databases, internet, and electronic medical record usage. Experience with Microsoft Office programs. Must be able to use basic office equipment including fax machine and telephone. Must have a valid driver's license.

Physical Demands:

This position requires an individual to be regularly available for work as scheduled. Position requires professional and personal skills to cope with stress associated with work involving a high degree of mental, emotional, and physical demands. This position also requires the ability to sit, stand, walk, bend, stoop, lift, push and pull on an ongoing basis. This position may occasionally require an individual to lift and transfer clients using a two-person lifting technique. Must be willing to work a flexible work schedule depending on program needs.

Work Environment:

The work environment will primarily be a residential setting and may require travel to other organizations, hospitals, and community locations within and outside of Central Oregon. Must have reliable transportation.

The position requires the employee to dress in a professional manner that meets the standards for professional employees in Central Oregon.
